Questions	Answers
<i>Am I eligible to become a SFEFCU member through MDCREA?</i>	Great News! South Florida Educational Federal Credit Union membership is a benefit we extend to all MDCREA members.
<i>How do I open a SFEFCU account?</i>	You may open an account with SFEFCU by simply visiting a Credit Union branch . Please visit www.sfefcu.org for additional identification requirement details.
<i>Is there a cost to join SFEFCU?</i>	To establish membership with the Credit Union, a minimum \$5 deposit to your savings account is required. Your new membership allows you to take full advantage of the products and services SFEFCU has to offer!
<i>Do the MDCREA Membership dues satisfy the Credit Union's \$5 minimum deposit requirement to open the account?</i>	MDCREA Membership is <u>separate</u> from the Credit Union membership. You are required to make a \$5 minimum deposit to open an account with SFEFCU.
<i>Is there an annual membership renewal cost for joining SFEFCU?</i>	No, there is no annual renewal fee to maintain your membership with the Credit Union.
<i>Will I lose my SFEFCU membership if I do not renew my membership with MDCREA?</i>	Your SFEFCU membership eligibility is only determined at the time of account opening. "Once a member, ALWAYS a member."
<i>To open an account with SFEFCU, will I need to provide or sign documentation acknowledging my membership with MDCREA?</i>	When you open a credit union account, you will sign an acknowledgment that you are a member of MDCREA. No further documentation is required.
